

ISLIP BOARD OF EDUCATION – March 2008

The Board of Education took the following actions on March 4, March 11, March 18, 2008:

March 4, 2008

- 1) Approved the participation of High School students in a field trip to West Point Military Academy to compete in the New York State Science Olympiad Competition scheduled for March 14-15, 2008.
- 2) Approved the participation of EXCEL students in a field trip to Binghamton, New York to compete in the Odyssey of the Mind State Competition scheduled for March 28-29, 2008.
- 3) Authorized entering into an employment agreement with Brian McCarthy for interim administrative services as an elementary principal for the period January 4, 2008 through June 30, 2008.
