RE: Board of Education Actions

The Board of Education took the following actions on March 4 and 25, 2009:

March 4, 2009

- 1) Approved Personnel Schedule A-4, No. 9 – Coaching Assignments.

March 25, 2009

- 1) Accepted the minutes from the following meetings:
 - Special Board of Education Meeting – February 4, 2009

- 2) Approved the following field trips:
 - Participation of Commack Road Elementary School fourth grade students in a field trip to Sailor’s Haven, Fire Island, which is scheduled for June 18, 2009; and
 - Participation of Middle School seventh grade purple team students in a field trip to Captree State Park for a fishing trip on the Great South Bay, which is scheduled for June 22, 2009.
- 3) Accepted the donation of one X-Box 360 Gaming System and one Rock Band Game from Richard Magale.
- 4) Accepted donations totaling \$3,062 to be deposited into the Kris McDonald Scholarship Fund to benefit High School students.

- 5) Accepted donations from SEPTA, authorized an increase in the General Fund Budget by the donated amounts, and appropriated the funds to the *Library Books – SES* and *Supervision Gen. Supplies – Wing* budget codes.
- 6) Approved salary agreements and conditions of employment for Central Office Administrators for the period July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009.
- 7) Authorized a budget transfer to cover changes in budget salaries due to column transfers and changes in employee assignments.
- 8) Authorized a budget transfer to cover expenses associated with the transportation of students to athletic competitions.
- 9) Approved additional election inspectors as substitutes, if needed, for the May 19, 2009 budget vote and election at an hourly rate of \$10 per hour, including light breakfast, lunch and dinner.
- 10) Approved an employment agreement for interim administrative services.
- 11) Authorized an agreement for consultant services during the 2008-09 school year.
- 12) Authorized a service contract for professional development services for administrators.
- 13) Approved Personnel Schedules.
- 14) Approved Special Education Schedules as listed on the March 25, 2009 agenda.
