August 5, 2009 Business Meeting

- 1) Adopted Policy 8414.6: Idling Prohibition for Buses and Other School Vehicles.
- 2) Accepted donations to be deposited into the *Class of 66 Scholarship Fund* to benefit High School students.
- 3) Authorized an agreement between the Board of Education of the Islip Union Free School District and Syosset Home Tutoring to provide academic tutoring and resource room services for the District for the period July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010.
