

The Board of Education took the following actions on March 3 and 17, 2010:

March 3, 2010

- 1) Adopted Policy 6410: Authorized Signatures.
- 2) Adopted amended Policy 8411: Transportation of Students.
- 3) Accepted a donation from Josten's to be deposited into the Josten's Scholarship Fund to benefit a High School student.
- 4) Accepted donations totaling \$850 from various contributors, increased the General Fund budget by this amount, and appropriated it to a budget code to be utilized to provide a Post Prom breakfast.
- 5) In accordance with Policy 6900, Disposal of District Property, declared equipment as surplus and obsolete.
- 6) Approved participation of High School Swing Choir students in a field trip to Six Flags Great Adventure, Jackson, New Jersey, to compete in a Vocal Jazz Competition scheduled for May 22, 2010.

March 17, 2010

- 2) Authorized an agreement between the Board of Education of the Islip Union Free School District and the Board of Education of the Seaford Union Free School District to provide instructional services in accordance with student IEPs for the period September 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010.
- 3) Authorized the transfer of funds to cover the debt service associated with the District's 2009-10 computer equipment lease purchase agreement.
- 4) Accepted donations totaling \$3,862.00 to be deposited into the *Kris McDonald Scholarship Fund* to benefit High School students.
- 5) Accepted donations totaling \$575.00 from various contributors, authorized an increase in the General Fund budget by this amount, and appropriated it to a budget code to be utilized to provide a Post Prom breakfast for graduating seniors and their guests.
