

**The Board of Education took the following actions on December 2 and 9, 2009:**

December 2, 2009

- 1) Approved 2009-2010 Contracts for Receipt of Federal Part B Flow-Through Allocations for Section 611 (for students with disabilities, ages 3-21) and Section 619 (for students with disabilities, ages 3-5) for the 2009-2010 program year consistent with Education Law §4410-b.
- 2) Authorized the formation of a Bible Club at Islip High School for the 2009-10 school year.
- 3) Authorized a two (2%) percent salary increase for the Superintendent of Schools retroactive to July 1, 2009.

December 9, 2009

- 1) Accepted the minutes of the following Board Meetings:

- 2) Amended Sections 2.1 (Eligibility) and 2.7 (Non-Elective Employer Contributions) of the Islip Public Schools 403(b) Retirement Plan Document that was adopted on December 17, 2008.
- 3) Authorized a budget transfer to cover expenses for related services required by IEPs.
- 4) Accepted the audit reports submitted by the auditing firm of R.S. Abrams & Co., LLP, CPA for the Islip Union Free School District for the 2008-2009 fiscal year.
- 5) Approved the participation of the wrestling team in a field trip to Paulsboro, New Jersey, which is scheduled for December 18-19, 2009, to compete in the Border Battle Tournament at Rowan University.
- 6) Declared equipment as surplus and obsolete in accordance with Policy 6900, Disposal of District Property.
- 7) Accepted a donation in the amount of \$1,836.88 from the Islip Drug Education Awareness Task Force, authorized an increase in the General Fund Budget by the donated amount, and appropriated the amount to the *Co-Curricular IDEA Task Force* budget code (A2850-565-00-855).
- 8) Approved Personnel Schedules.
- 9) Approved Special Education Schedules.

- 11) Entered into an employment agreement with Lynn Burke for interim administrative services as an elementary principal for the period December 14, 2009 through March 19, 2010, or the return of the Commack Road Elementary School Principal, whichever occurs first.
- 12) Accepted a donation in the amount of \$6,600 from the Islip High School Post Prom, authorized an increase in the General Fund Budget by the donated amount, and appropriated the amount to the *Co-Curricular Community Relations* budget code (A2850-569-00-855). These funds will be utilized to provide a Post Prom breakfast for graduating seniors and their guests.
