The Board of Education took the following actions on May 5, 18 and 19, 2010:

May 5, 2010

- 1) Accepted a \$250 gift card from Stop and Shop and monetary donations totaling \$230 from various contributors, increased the General Fund budget by this amount, and appropriated it to a budget code to be utilized to provide a Post Prom breakfast.
- 2) Accepted donations totaling \$20 from various contributors, authorized an increase in the General Fund budget by this amount, and appropriated it to a budget code to be utilized for the Senior Citizen Prom.
- 3) Accepted donations totaling \$2,140 from various contributors, authorized an increase in the General Fund budget by this amount, and appropriated it to a budget code to be utilized for the CRES 5th Grade Moving Up Celebration.
- 4) Abolished the following positions: one Assistant Superintendent for Educational Services, seven elementary teachers, one business teacher, one foreign language teacher, one foreign language/ESL teacher, two ESL teachers, one mathematics teacher, one social studies/English teacher, one health teacher, one special education teacher, one LPN, seven teaching assistants, one security monitor, one driver messenger, and one clerk typist.
- 5) Authorized an agreement between the District and Lawrence F. Spirn to work in the capacity of consultant during the 2009-10 school year.
- 6) Authorized a budget transfer to cover payroll expenses associated with clerical staff.
- 7) Awarded the contract for Partial Roof Replacement at Wing Elementary School to Marpat Construction Corp.
- 8) Authorized service agreements between the District and the following:
 - All About Kids for the provision of related services for students with handicapping conditions for the period July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011;
 - Bay Shore Union Free School District for the provision of special education programs and services for students in situations where the Islip Union Free School District is unable to provide these services for the period July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011;

- 7) Authorized a contract and Rider to Agreement between the Islip Union Free School District and Billmar Amusements NY Party Works, Inc. to provide entertainment for the Post Prom Breakfast.
- 8) Authorized an agreement between the Islip Union Free School District and Manor Transportation Consulting Service for purposes of reviewing student transportation bus routes for SED reporting, subject to approval by legal counsel.
- 9) Accepted the donation of \$750.00 from the Al and Deena Garod Family Charitable Fund to be deposited into the *Al Garod Scholarship Fund* to benefit High School students.
- 10) In accordance with Policy 6900, Disposal of District Property, declared textbooks and equipment as surplus and obsolete.
- 11) Abolished the Coordinator of Fine and Performing Arts position effective June 30, 2010 and reinstated the position of Director of Fine and Performing Arts as per a previous agreement in the 2009-10 school year.
