It's always fun to hear a story, and to talk about it with another person. Then, complete the graphic organizer when it is finished. Be sure to write on the top of the paper that the book was read to you.

These reports are due by the third week of September. That way, if you have any difficulties completing the work, your classroom teacher can help.
