Student Locker Clean-Out - June 8, June 9, and June 10 (End of the School Day)

<u>District Laptop Return</u> - All school-distributed laptops/devices should be returned to the Technology Office at IHS by Friday, June 11, UNLESS needed for participation in any of the high school's Academic Recovery Programs. The Technology Office will provide the school community with additional information regarding the collection of laptops.

School Cafeteria - The HS cafeteria will be open to students during both Recovery/Enrichment and Regents Exam days, with a limited menu and hours of service.

<u>Regents Exam Opt-In</u> - Students wishing to opt in on taking one of the four Regents Examinations offered by the NYSED must complete the Regents Exam Enrollment Form by Friday, June 4, on the District's website. The link can be found under the Curriculum and Instruction Department tab. If a student plans on taking a Regents Examination, please see the following regarding cell phones:

Such devices include, but are not limited to: Cell phones, iPods and MP3 players, iPads, tablets, and other e-Readers. Personal laptops, notebooks, or any other personal computing devices. Cameras or other photographic equipment; wearable devices/smart wearables, including smart watches and health wearables with a display. Headphones, headsets, or in-ear headphones such as earbuds, and any other device capable of recording audio, photographic or video content, or capable of viewing or playing back such content.
